Strategic Plan 2014-2018

1. INTRODUCTION

This Strategic Plan incorporates the time period up to and including the next Southwark Borough Council elections, which are due to be held on Thursday 3rd May 2018.

The plan includes a Core Objective, and several Key Targets. The Plan should be used to plan the programme of political, fundraising and social programmes over the next four years; and should be incorporated into any campaign planning for the Parliamentary election in May 2015 and the Greater London Authority elections in 2016.

2. CORE OBJECTIVE

To elect three Conservative Councillors in each of the two Target Wards, namely Surrey Docks and Riverside, at the Southwark Borough Council elections, due to be held on Thursday 3rd May 2018.

3. KEY TARGETS

- 3.1 To ensure that there is one voter contact per quarter in the Target Wards: either literature, canvassing, or survey.
- 3.2 To achieve, by 31st December 2017, 1,750 pledges, including 1,400 'C' pledges, in each of Target Wards, through a varied voter identification programme, including surveys, doorstep canvassing, telephone canvassing, and through social media.
- 3.3 To increase Association membership to a level equal to 3% of the vote achieved at the previous General Election, i.e. 229 members. This should include 30 members in each of the Target Wards.
- 3.4 To have a strong social and traditional media presence.
- 3.5 To engage in our communities and be a visible and vocal presence.
- 3.6 To increase our fundraising activities in order to fund our ongoing campaigning activities.

4. REVIEW

Each year, the Executive Council shall review and update the Strategic Plan.
